Agency Overview

- Children's Harbor is a 501(c)(3) child welfare organization founded in 1996, in cooperation with the City of Pembroke Pines.
- Our mission is to provide therapeutic services to children and families in crisis, a safe and nurturing environment for children in foster care, and advocacy within the child welfare system
- We have opened 5 homes between 2004 and 2008 giving us the capability to care for 34 children removed from their homes due to abuse or neglect.

Programs and Services

- Our **Residential Programs** serve two populations.
 - ***Pregnant and or parenting foster teens and their babies:***
 - We are the *only* program dedicated to this population in Broward County.
 - Residents are 13-18 years old, who find themselves pregnant while in the care and custody of the State of Florida.
 - In this program we have capacity for 5 mothers and 5 babies.
 - ***Sibling groups who are in the care and custody of the State of Florida:***
 - Children range in age from 0-18 years old and all enter care with one or more sibling.
 - We utilize a house parent model, in which parents actually live full time on our campus and care for these children in our homes providing as "normal" as an environment as possible.
 - Each home has the capacity to care for six foster children, allowing us the capability to provide homes for up to 24 children in our Sibling Homes program.
- Our **Family Intervention Program** works to keep at risk families together, through counseling and case management. We teach alternate parenting behaviors and address whatever issues confront these families.
