Family Intervention Program

Who We Serve

Eligible Families must:

- Reside in Broward County;
- Have a child between 0-18 years old living in the home;
- Include a parent or guardian willing to participate;

Additionally,

- Participation in the program is voluntary
- Referrals are accepted through BSO, ChildNet, Community agencies; schools; and can be self-referred;
- Services are available in English, Creole, and Spanish;
- No one will be turned away for the inability to pay
- No Insurance is necessary; Program is based on a sliding fee scale based on income.

The Program

- Weekly in-home counseling, family preservation services, and case management services;
- Sessions last approx. 1.5-2.5 hours and can be conducted on evenings and week-ends;
- We work closely with each family member to optimize success;
- The minimum length of service is twelve weeks, but may extend up to a year as long as the child remains in the home;
- Parent education training using the best practices model *Nurturing Skills for Families* curriculum;
- We work in cooperation with all referral sources to monitor each family's progress



Reasons for Referrals include, but are not limited to:

- Child/Teen Mental Health or Behavioral Problems
- Academic Performance
- Parenting Skills
- Poor Communication
- Delinquency Interventions
- Co-Parenting/ Adjustment to Divorce
- Grief and Loss Counseling
- Teen Pregnancy
- Poor Bonding, Poor Attachment
- Child Abuse and Neglect
- Exposure to Domestic Violence
- Parent or Child Substance Abuse
- Family Economic Hardship
