## SIBLING RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

- Siblings stay together in a therapeutic home environment while they are in foster care.
- A consistency of caregiving is provided by house parents who live in the homes with the children.
- Residents participate in group and individual therapy.

### Last year:

- 25 children, or 7 families, were able to live with their brothers and sisters for a total of 6,266 nights.
- 100% of the children achieved 80% or more of their treatment plan goals.
- 100% of the children surveyed were satisfied with the program.

## RESIDENTIAL MATERNITY PROGRAM

- Pregnant and/or parenting foster teens and their babies are provided with a loving home.
- Teens participate in individual and group therapy, as well as parenting and independent living skills groups.
- The goal is to break the intergenerational cycle of abuse.

### Last year:

- 7 teenagers and 7 babies found a home within our residential maternity program for 1,808 nights.
- 100% of the teens participated in all recommended prenatal and postnatal medical appointments.
- 100% of the teens resolved or partially resolved 80% of their goals when discharged from the program.

## FAMILY STRENGTHENING PROGRAM

- At-risk families receive intensive in-home counseling and case management services to strengthen family relationships.
- Staff is available by phone 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Counselors work with all members of the family.

### Last year:

- 418 families were served.
- 100% of the families served were satisfied with the program.
- 90% of the families who were admitted to the program successfully completed program.
- 92.3% families resolved or partially resolved 80% of their goals upon program completion.

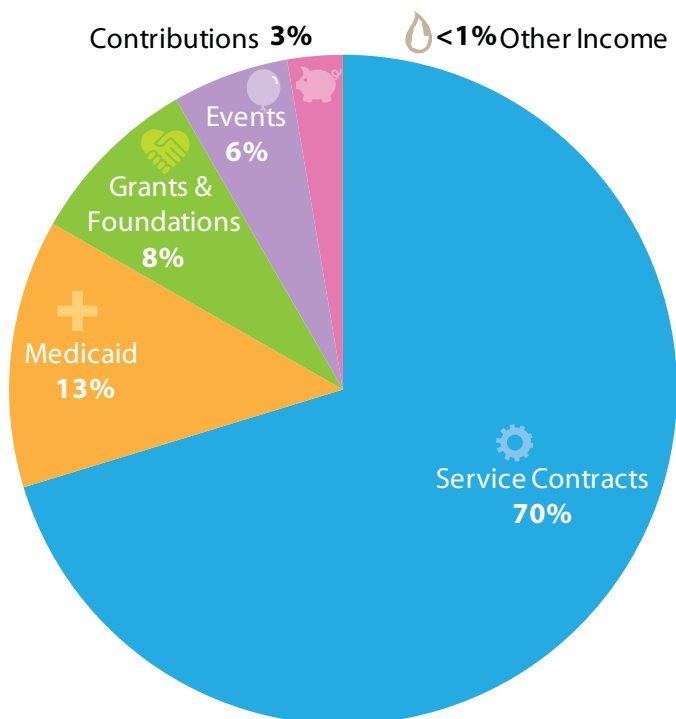
